Letter to Chief Executive Dublin Bus concerning services in our county - 22-08-00

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you in connection with bus routes from Bray to the City Centre and the proposed QBC from Foxrock Church to Bray. I have a number of questions/proposals which I would be grateful for your feedback on.

1. Currently at peak times, many the 46A busses line up at Foxrock Church. When they come out from town, why not get them to go a couple of miles further to Loughlinstown roundabout (just before the motorway starts). These could then pick up passengers between Loughlinstown and Foxrock before making their way into town.
2. Eliminate the existing 45 route and instead have it go town via the N11 QBC. This could if necessary be complemented with a smaller, less frequent bus that starts at Cornelscourt and goes along the Clonkeen Road to Blackrock and on into town.
3. Reduce the number of 45 busses that go through Blackrock and allocate them instead to a route from Bray directly to town via the N11 QBC.

I am sending a copy of this letter to the Minister for Public Enterprise as I have been disappointed by the lack of response I have received to letters I have sent to other parts of your organisation.
