

## **Letter to managing director Adshel 03-10-99**

Dear Mr. Buckley:

My name is Eoin Costello and I am a councilor with Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council. There are an increasing number of Adshel shelters in the area I represent. Unfortunately, local vandals regularly smash them. The smashed glass can lie strewn across the pavement for up to 3 days, posing a risk to local children and the elderly.

My reason for writing is to ask the following;

1. Why doesn't your company use 15 millimeter plate glass instead of 10 millimeter glass? This is much harder to smash.
2. Given that users of Adshel shelters often deposit large amounts of litter at bus stops shelters why doesn't your company provide litter bins within the structure of all your shelters?
3. Why doesn't your company provide a freephone number prominently displayed (beside the new shelter address system you have introduced) for members of the public to notify your maintenance depot of all smashed Adshel shelters?
